

Brief Report on ICICSE -2014

GNITC and GNIT has organized a two day international conference on Innovations in Computer Science and Engineering ICICSE-2014 on 8th and 9th August, 2014. This second conference in succession to our 1st conference held successfully during last September. The focus of ICICSE 2014 is to provide an opportunity for all the professional and aspiring researchers, scientists, academicians and engineers to exchange their innovative ideas and new research findings in the field of computer science and engineering.

As curtain raiser of the conference, we have organized two day pre-conference tutorial for the students, research scholars and faculties in the emerging technologies such as “Cyber Security” which was convened by Dr. C.
